German churches in the Nazi state and widespread support of its policies has increasingly undercut ubiquitous German claims of innocence During the first years after the war, many or most Germans, Christians and otherwise, claimed never to have supported Adolf Hitler and not to have been responsible for atrocities committed by the Nazi regime

The Nazi Economic System

centuries had all but disappeared It was not State capitalism: the government disclaimed any desire to own the means of production, and in fact took steps to denationalize them It was not socialism or communism: private property and private profit still existed The Nazi system was, rather, a combination of some of the characteristics
